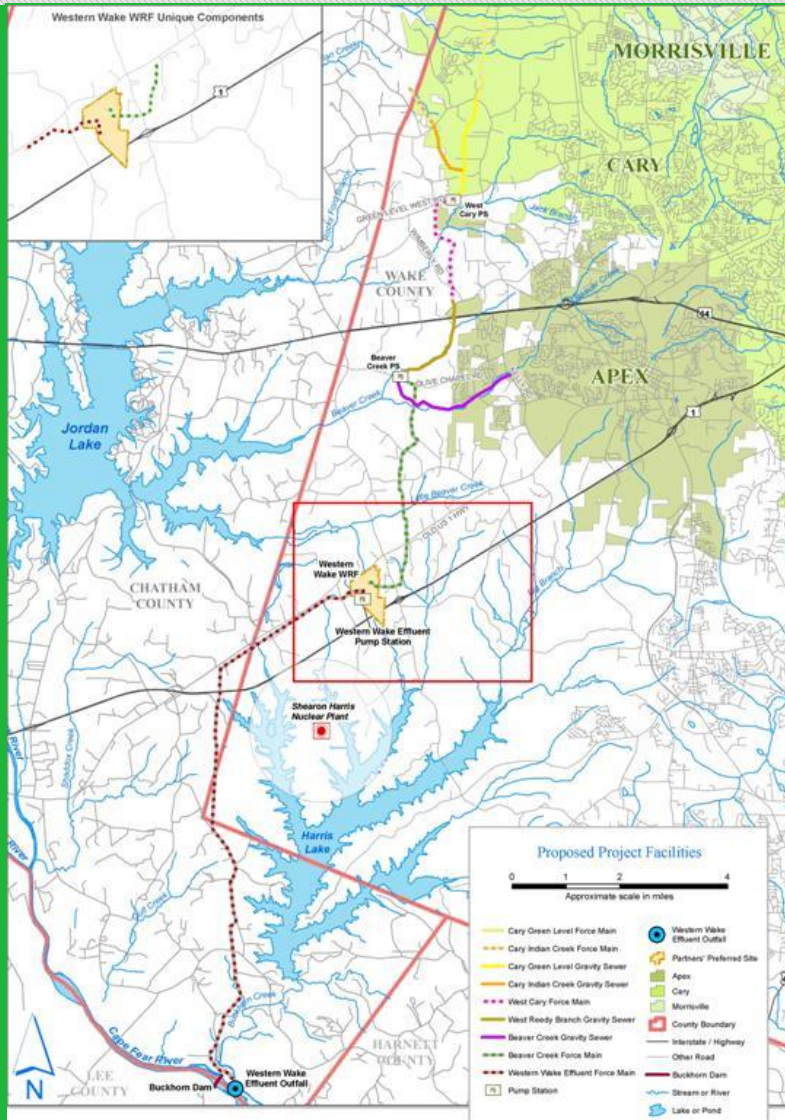

Project Background

- ▶ Apex, Cary & Morrisville working as partners to:
 - *Provide adequate wastewater treatment capacity*
 - *Meet IBT requirements*
 - *Return water to Cape Fear River*
 - *Provide improved water and sewer availability*
- ▶ Extensive planning and public participation process began in 2002

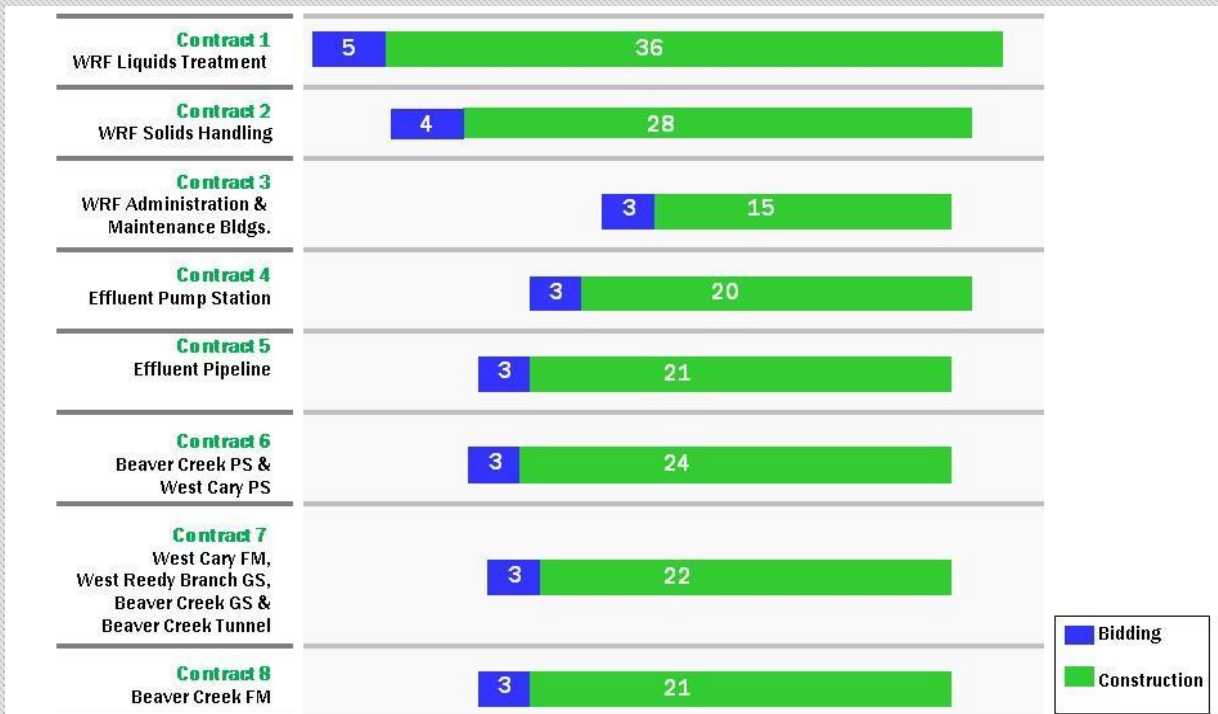


Project Overview

- ▶ Eight single-prime construction contracts
 - 1 – *WRF Liquid Treatment*
 - 2 – *Solids Handling*
 - 3 – *Administration & Maintenance Buildings*
 - 4 – *Effluent Pump Station*
 - 5 – *Effluent Pipeline*
 - 6 – *Beaver Creek & West Cary Pump Stations*
 - 7 – *West Cary Force Main, West Reedy Branch Gravity Sewer & Beaver Creek Gravity Sewer*
 - 8 – *Beaver Creek Force Main*
- ▶ Construction estimates span \$4.5M to \$100M

Project Schedule

- ▶ 36 month construction duration
- ▶ Staggered bid dates – completion in fall 2014
- ▶ Other related projects through Cary and Apex



MWBE Utilization Plan

- ▶ Purpose of the plan
 - *Promote awareness of contracting opportunities*
 - *Promote access to contracting opportunities*
 - *Monitor utilization of MWBE businesses*
 - *Monitor general contractor compliance with policy*
- ▶ MWBE participation – 10% goal
- ▶ Construction Contracts (and subcontractors)
- ▶ Professional Services

- ▶ Coordinate with other MWBE programs
- ▶ Identify needed trades, procurement items & specialties
- ▶ Attend workshops

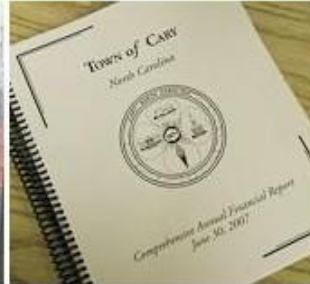
